Date - Saturday 12th June 2010

Entries- All entries must be submitted with a qualifying score by the **24th May**.

Round

Experienced Gents: Gents FITA (90m/70m/50m/30m)

Experienced Ladies/Novice Gents: Ladies FITA & Metric I (70m/60m/50m/30m)

Novice Ladies: Metric II: (60m/50m/40m/30m)

The first two distances of the round will be shot in timed ends of six arrows with timing controlled by an electronic timer system with countdown clocks. The time allowed for six arrows will be four minutes. The second two distances will be shot in timed ends of three arrows. The time allowed for three arrows will be two minutes. Before the round begins there will be 45 minutes of timed practice, in timed ends of four minutes. During practice archers may shoot as many arrows as they want to in the time allowed.

Metal Detectors and Helpers

If your club owns a metal detector, we would be very grateful if you could bring the metal detector with you. A system will be implemented to ensure that all metal detectors are well looked after and that the person in charge of it is accountable for any damage to the metal detector. In order to enable the shoot to run as smoothly as possible the host university are looking to build a large field party to assist in the running of the day. Equipment/Catering/Clothing

Please ensure that all archers come prepared for the conditions, with equipment for both wet weather and hot weather. There will be a burger van on site selling hot food throughout the day of shooting, or alternatively competitors can bring a packed lunch. All competitors are advised to bring plenty of water with them to drink throughout the day (at least one litre per person). There will not be time to leave the shoot at lunchtime to purchase food from a supermarket. All archers should be wearing GNAS coloured clothing or registered club colours in accordance with rule 307. Jeans are not permitted.

Camping

There will be camping facilities available for the nights of the 11th and 12th June. This will be charged per tent per night at a rate of £7 per tent. Please note that no vehicles will be allowed on the camping field at any time. Fires and barbecues are strictly prohibited. On the night of the 11th June there must be no noise after 11pm to ensure that competitors can get adequate rest before the competition the next day. All campers must have left the camping field and cleared away all of their kit and litter by 10am on 13 June. Camping fees will be collected at the event. For any clubs who are camping there will be a refundable damage deposit of £50.

Boat Race

There will be a four man (drinking) boat race after the conclusion of shooting and results. If your club wishes to enter a team for this please supply your own drinks. Plastic pint glasses can be supplied by the organisers. Please note that at least one member of the team must be consuming an alcoholic beverage.
